



TEDA Recognition of Outstanding Service to The Community of Educational Diagnosticians

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Texas Educational Diagnosticians' Association (TEDA) will recognize outstanding service to the professional community of Educational Diagnosticians.

1. Board members, advisors, and committee chairs will be recognized (verbal and/or certificate) at the Annual Conference.
2. Additional recognition may be given as determined by the TEDA Board to include:
 - a. Hall of Honor
 - i. TEDA Hall of Honor recognition is the highest honor given by TEDA to recognize members, former members, and others who have demonstrated outstanding service to the professional community of Educational Diagnosticians and the TEDA organization.  - ii. Refer to www.txeda.org for the current year deadlines to submit nominations.
3. Educational Diagnostician of the Year
 - i. *Chapters are encouraged to consider these guidelines if they choose to establish their own system of recognizing outstanding service.*
 - ii. Diagnostician of the Year recognition is the honor given by a Chapter to recognize a member who has demonstrated outstanding service to the professional community of Educational Diagnosticians and the Chapter.
